THE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDIUM REMCO KOERTS AND PAOLO APRILE, ON 29th OCTOBER WERE RECEIVED AT THE BERLAYMONT BUILDING.





The meeting, which required a long and accurate preliminary preparation, was prompted by a request from Vice-President Aprile to Commissioner Fitto's Secretariat, aimed at presenting to the EU's highest executive body the many commendable activities that A.E.H.T. has been carrying out for countless years on behalf of young Europeans and to affirm and consolidate their sense of belonging to the European Union and its founding values.

Vice Presidents Koerts and Aprile outlined the history of the A.E.H.T. Association, its composition, organizational structure, mission, and its many activities, with particular reference to its three main activities: the *Annual Conference and Competitions*, *Christmas in Europe*, and the *European Youth Parliament*.





Executive Vice President Fitto listened with great interest, raising the possibility of closer collaboration with the European Commission, including through the involvement not only of his own sector, but also of the sector of Tourism, with Commissioner Apostolos Tzitzikostas, and the sector of Intergenerational Equity, Youth, Culture, and Sport, with Commissioner Glenn Micallef.

Finally, Executive Vice President Fitto asked the Presidium members to prepare a document representing A.E.H.T.'s activities and a proposal for collaboration with the European Commission to support the Association's activities.

The Presidium members warmly welcomed the proposal, declaring their readiness and inviting Executive Vice-President Fitto, or a high-ranking Commission representative, to attend an edition of the A.E.H.T. *Annual Conference*, so as to be able to see first-hand the consistency and scope of the Association's activities for Europe and its young people.
